Re-Entry Plan

Please read Grande Yellowhead Public School Division's Re-Entry Plan as posted on the gypsd.ca website: [Re-Entry Plan](#). Niton Central School daily routines from last year will remain in place at this time. This includes:

1. Front entry/exit doors for students. Three designated entries and exits. **(JKG/KG, Elementary, Junior High)** Signage used. Classes will be in Cohorts (JKG/KG, Gr. 1-2, Gr. 3-4, Gr. 5-6 and Gr.7-9) for all breaks as per GYPSD re-entry plan.
2. Only staff and students will be permitted to enter the school, parents/community must book an appointment or wait in the office reception.

3. All staff and students agree to take the [Alberta Health Daily Checklists](#) every morning and stay home if they answer yes to any of the questions.
4. At all school entries hand sanitizers will be available and required prior to entering the school.
5. Sanitizing and cleaning of surfaces and high use areas throughout the day.
6. Two students maximum in bathrooms.
7. Water bottles for personal use are highly recommended.
8. Lockers will be assigned.
9. Students must be seated to eat lunch. There will be limited social distanced seating where lunch can be eaten. Students will be asked to disinfect any eating station before and after using. Microwaves, vending machines will not be provided. Sharing of food is prohibited.
10. **JR High (grade 7 - 9) students will be allowed to be off-campus for lunch providing students have parental permission. This form was emailed to parent/guardian emails on Friday, September 3, 2021.**
