Alberta Assurance Measures

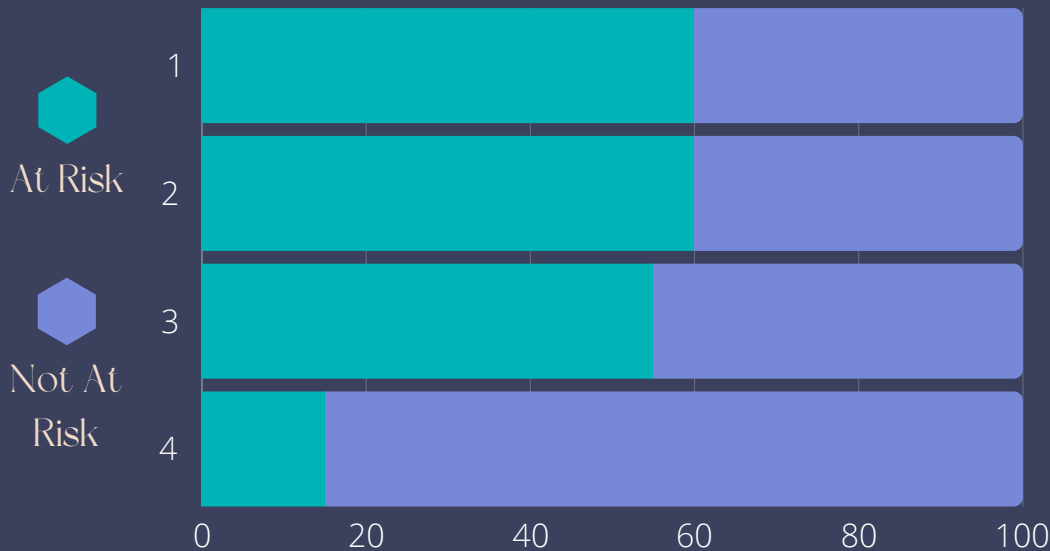
This is an annual survey for parents, students, and teachers regarding all aspects of education that is from spring 2023. We had many areas above the provincial average and one area of growth.

Alberta Education Screen Results

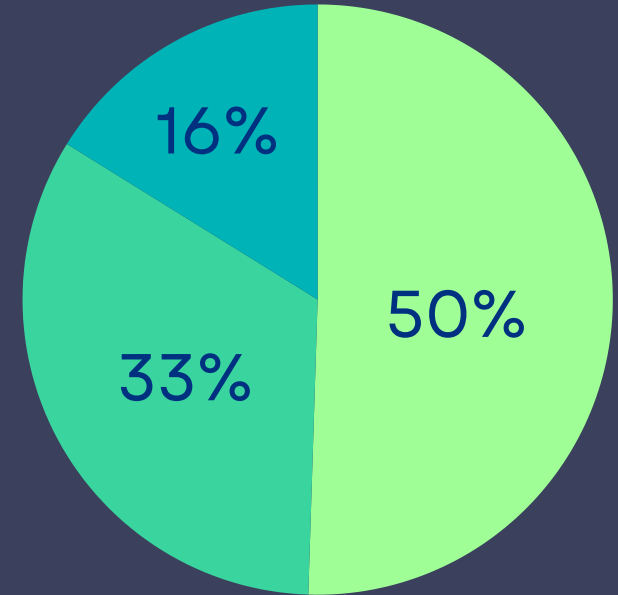
In spring 2023, students completed screens in literacy and numeracy. NCS shows a clear reduction in students at risk as we move from grade one to four.

- Sept. 2023 - Parents were shared successes and areas for growth from the assurance survey and June 2023 screens at the school council meeting.
- School goals have been shared in weekly parent memos.

LITERACY GOAL

All students will have a strong foundation in phonological awareness and ability to understand phonics.

All students will develop a grade appropriate writing stamina utilizing basic literacy skills for quality written work.

NUMERACY GOAL

All students will have a concrete understanding of numbers sense, what numbers represent, basic math facts/ operations, and problem solving.



90 DAY ACTION PLAN

90 DAY PLAN

Throughout our first 90 days we will,

- Training for K-3 teachers on phonics program.
- Increased access to reading.
- Math focused on foundational skills in grades 4 - 9.
- Setting up classroom groupings for targeted supports and intervention weekly.

WHAT COULD HOLD US BACK?

The obstacles to address are,

- Large and diverse gap in student needs and ability levels.
- Missing foundational skills.
- Emphasizing must know curricular skills.

180 DAY PLAN

Throughout our next 180 days we will,

- Review at risk student growth and remove roadblocks to success.
- Daily phonics program use.
- Ongoing targeted groupings based on student need in mathematics.
- Daily spiral math used in grades 4 - 9.

Within 90 Days we will see,

- Improved use of students groups to receive targeted supports.
- Using tasks that work for all student levels.
- Increased benchmark results.
- Increased math fact ability.
